Prof. Dr. Klemens Budde is Senior Physician at the Medical Clinic with a focus on Nephrology and Internal Intensive Care Medicine at Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin. Since 2006 he has held the professorship for pharmacodynamics of immunosuppression after kidney transplantation.

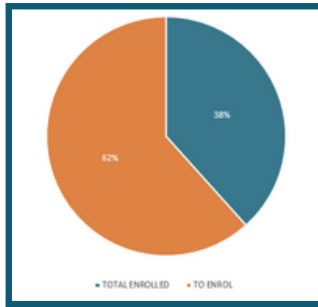
In 2004, Klemens Budde received the Hans U. Zollinger Research Award of the Society of Nephrology for outstanding achievements in his field. He is a member of numerous national and international medical associations. Since 2016, he has been leading the Medical Allround-Care Service Solutions (MACSS) project funded by the German Federal Ministry of Economics and Technology (BMW), in which partners from science and industry are developing a patient-centred smart health service platform.

ABOUT CHARITÉ

Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin, was established in 1710 as a center for plague patients and 100 years later it grew to house a medical university. From then on, its campus has hosted patients as well as research students. More than half of Germany's Nobel Prize winners for medicine or physiology worked at the hospital. Today Charité consists of about 100 departments and institutes in 17 Centers. It is the biggest transplant Center in Germany with more than 200 transplants a year.

In the [Newsweek](#) rankings of the world's best hospitals 2021 (produced in conjunction with consumer data company Statista), Charité came sixth out of a total of 1,000. According to Newsweek and Statista, this makes Charité the best hospital in Europe. Performance indicators taken into account include recommendations from medical professionals and hospital staff as well as patient survey results.

The German weekly news magazine [Focus](#) placed Charité highest in its rankings of the best 100 German hospitals, crowning it 'Best German Hospital' for the tenth year running. In addition to its 78 outstanding specialist departments, Charité boasts 87 medical specialists who have been rated as among the leading physicians in their field. The 2022 Focus hospital rankings were based on a comparison of data from more than 1,600 hospitals and represent the most comprehensive review of hospital care within German-speaking countries.



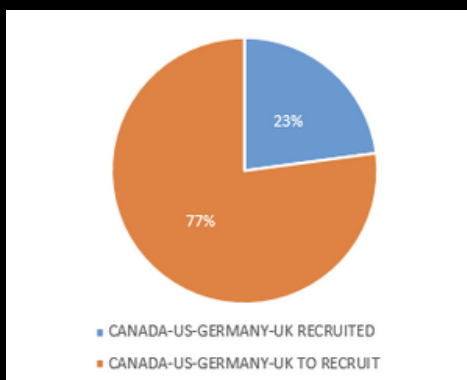
